1. *What is an API?*

API stands for application programming interface and is a technique for sharing information between online services and applications.

2. *What is Porsche Bank API?*

Porsche Bank API is the technical interface to access Porsche Bank data as an external party. It gives you as a business a chance to build and/or expand your own application using the data of a specific Porsche Bank customer.

3. *How do I get the Client ID and Client Secret Key for my application?*

When you register an application on your account, your application credentials, i.e. Client ID and Client Secret Key, are created for you. You'll need these to make calls from your application to Porsche Bank API endpoints.
